WHAT are the COVID-19 symptoms:

- a high temperature (37.8 degrees and above)
- a new, continuous cough

If you develop these symptoms call NHS 111 and go into self-isolation. If your symptoms worsen during home isolation or are no better after 7 days contact NHS 111 or online 111.nhs.uk. If you have no internet access, you should call NHS 111 and for a medical emergency dial 999.
