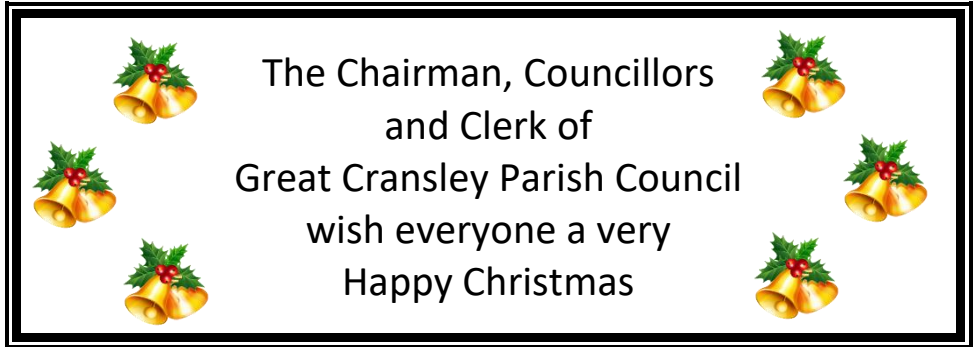

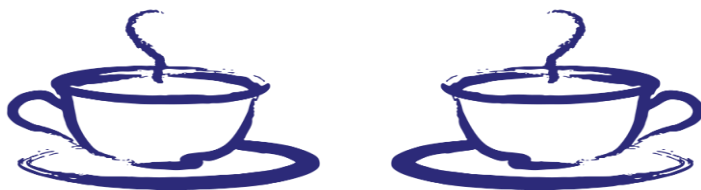

WHAT IS 'WHAT 3 WORDS' AND WHAT IS IT FOR???

It is for emergencies, and the Emergency Services are encouraging people to download the 'What 3 Words' app onto their smart phones, as it makes it quicker and easier for them to respond to emergencies if the 'What 3 Words' location is provided.

'What 3 Words' is a free smart phone app, that divides the world into 3-meter squares.

Every 3-meter square has a unique three-word reference.

The app is particularly beneficial when incidents occur in rural locations.

The quickest way to access the app, to download it, is to just ask your search engine for the 'What 3 Words' app.

What 3 words.com provides lots of useful information.

Please consider downloading the app. It may help you, or another person, and the time saved in responding to your call could save a life.
