SCAM CONNECTED WITH COVID 19 VACCINE

Trading standards have been advising people of a scam in relation to the Covid 19 vaccine.

People are being sent a text message claiming to be from the NHS which informs the recipient "we have identified that you are eligible to apply for your vaccine". The message ends with a link to a website mocked up to look like a legitimate NHS platform. The website requests personal details, including name, address and banking details.

Please remember: The NHS will never ask for bank details, passwords or pin numbers, and these requests should serve as instant red flags.
