## **CRANSLEY WAR MEMORIAL**

The stonework cleaning has now been completed. There was a problem concerning the lettering at the base giving the names of the soldiers, because this was so fragile that the stone mason considered if any cleaning was attempted, it might make the names unreadable.

The pebbles on the ground surrounding the Memorial have been removed, with help, by the Parish Council Chairman and new pebbles have been put down on top of Teran which will prevent weeds growing through. As originally hoped at the start of this project, it has all been completed by November 11<sup>th</sup>.

There will be a Service of Remembrance at the War Memorial on November 11<sup>th</sup> at 11 am.
