DOGS BANNED FROM CHILDREN'S PLAY AREAS

Under a new Public Spaces Protection Order, dogs are banned from all Children's Play Areas. Kettering Borough Council has put a new notice on the fence adjacent to the gate at the children's playground in Great Cransley. Despite this very plain notice adults have been seen taking dogs into the playground. Dogs could be tied up to the fence or to the seat outside the playground. Breaching this order results in a £100 fine.
