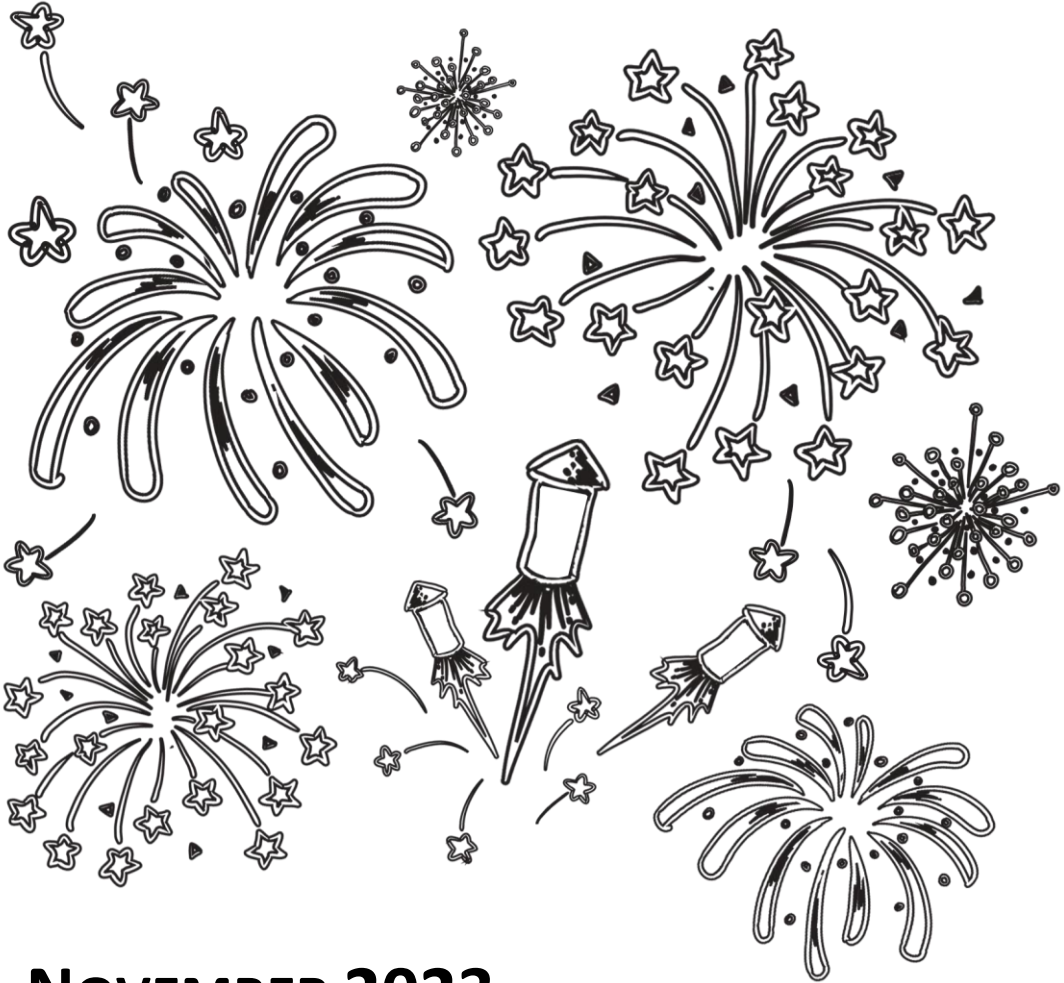

FRIDAY 3RD NOVEMBER Loddington Recreation Ground gates open at 6.45 pm, fireworks start at 7.20 pm. Admission adults £5, children under 16 free when accompanied by a paying adult.

SATURDAY 4TH NOVEMBER Mawsley gates open at 4.30 pm, bonfire and fireworks from 6.30 pm. Admission adults £5, children under 16 free when accompanied by a paying adult.

ARE YOU READY TO VOTE?

Voter Identification will require voters to prove their identity by showing a form of photographic identification, before being given their ballot paper in polling stations across Great Britain at national UK-wide elections, and at local elections and neighbourhood planning referendums in England.

A broad range of documents, both in date and expired, will be accepted in order to prove your identity to vote or you can apply for a voter authority certificate using this link: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate>
